Group 1

As a group, what is your preferred alternative? Please explain your reasoning.

- #1, restroom at the front (on Colorado Avenue), no pavilion

As a group, what three elements of the preferred alternative does your group agree are the most favorable? Please explain your reasoning.

- Restroom location
- No pavilion
- Addition plaza space

As a group, if you could change one thing about the preferred alternative what would that be?

- Add the additional plaza space from plan #2. Eventually close Colbrunn and this space would all flow together - only close Colbrunn from May to September.

- #1 we like, but please leave the pavilion!! Minus the walls where vagrants sleep. Please remove the playground – 3 other parks with equipment for kids are already within walking distance. If there must be a playground, #1 is the least offensive.

- Bandshell security #3, if pavilion stays #12 (lighting and open), restroom #17, no playground preferable but best design is #19, bench #36 (concrete couch could add art), tables #42 or #43, bike area #50, lighting #53, pavers and concrete #59, trees #71, 72, 74, Colbrunn #80, No skate park, PLEASE NO
- The pavilion, if kept, can be used for City revenue. If people rent the park for any sort of party/event they will want a place to gather.
